## Letter from the President

### Happy Halloween!



Are you ready? Me, neither! There's candy to buy, decorations to put out and a costume to make.

Yes, I'm one of "those" who makes her Halloween costume for our neighbor's Halloween Party every year. But, "make" doesn't always mean 'sew from scratch'. Sometimes it means putting together the right pieces to create a look.

Sure, last year, I made my husband's and my costumes from scratch, but those were simple costumes – a couple of tunics and a cape, so I could be an archer and my husband, a king. But the year before that, we were lumberjacks – wearing checked flannel shirts, jeans, boots and a knit stocking cap. We even carried plastic axes to complete the look.

Quilting is a lot like that.

For one of my quilts, I individually cut out over 500 3  $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares from 100 different fabrics to get the scrappy look I wanted. For another quilt, I bought a package of 10-inch squares and simply sewed them together.

Both quilts finished out beautifully. And when people admire them, they don't know how long it took me to make them and I don't volunteer that information.

It doesn't matter.

It doesn't matter how you get to the finish line as long as you get there ...and that you enjoy the journey.

### Have you ever wondered about...


The term quilt comes from the Latin *culcita* meaning a stuffed sack. Visit this site for more information. <u>https://www.quilting-in-america.com/</u>

# Tid Bits

#1 Which end is the top? Which direction do you need to press a row? Where is that "oops" that you need to fix later? Mark it! Double tie a piece of ribbon onto a medium-sized safety pin. It is inexpensive, not bulky, you can choose your favorite color and make as many as you need.





#2 Make a cheat sheet for your needles. Whether you are taking one out of your machine or have one stuck in a pin cushion, you can quickly determine the size without having to find a container of similar needles by comparing the color marking on the needle and your handy dandy needle cheat sheet that simply shows the # and the color (dig out those sharpies or crayons).
