RED DRESS PROJECT

We are challenging our members to make a red dress block in honor of Women's Heart Health month. The pattern can be found at <u>www.fatcatpatterns.com</u>. The finished block should be a red dress in an approximately 8 x 12 inch block.

Embellishments are encouraged. Please turn your completed block into Kathy Scott no later than the July meeting. The collected blocks will be made into a quilt by the January 2018 Women's Heart Health month.

DID YOU KNOW?

A **layer cake** is a collection of 10" squares. Approximately 2 ³/₄ yards of fabric are in a layer cake. Note that different manufacturers use different names. A **charm pack** is a collection of 5" squares.

A mini charm pack is 2 ¹/₂" x 2 ¹/₂" pre cuts. Usually 42 pieces.

A jelly roll has forty 2 ¹/₂" x 44" strips of fabric.

Honey Buns are not as available as they once were. If you can find them, they are $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 44" strips. Using a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance produces a 1" strip.

Dessert Rolls are "double" jelly rolls. They are 5" x 44" strips.

Honeycombs – fairly new and hexagon shaped. They measure 6" from point-to-point, $5 \frac{1}{4}$ " horizontally.

Turnovers – these are triangles and not as common as other shapes. May be 10", 6" or $6\frac{1}{2}$ ". Also called half square triangles.

PROGRAMS

Our speaker for June is MJ Fielek. MJ lives in McKinney, Texas and has been sewing and quilting for over 40 years. Her natural talent for selecting color combinations and her attention to detail are reflected in her many quilts. During the sixties she lived in Taiwan, where her already keen eye for fabric quality, color and design were sharpened.

MJ teaches beginners classes, a tips and techniques class, binding and advanced classes such as Double Wedding Ring, Feathered Star and Lone Star. Her binding classes have become the class to take. She teaches two color binding, stuffed binding and how to make perfect corners on all your quilts.

At our June meeting, MJ will talk about *My Quilt Journey*. She will present examples of her earliest quilts to more recent efforts. She will discuss early attempts and her progressive development in color and design of her quilts.

PLACEMAT PROJECT FOR MEALS ON WHEELS

Thank you to those who have already made placemats for the Meals on Wheels project. The recipients truly appreciate the special touch you add to their holiday and beyond. Last year we donated 87 placemats!!

The placemats are approximately 14"x19". Any similar size is fine. Some thoughts:

- You don't have to use Christmas fabric, but you can. Some fabric is available from Lorraine or Betty. This is a great way to use scraps.
- Consider quilting as you go at least the top to the batting. This is great for strips or center theme fabric surrounded by accents.
- I like to use warm and natural batting if quilting as I go, but other batting is fine if not too thick. I will have some batting precut at the June meeting for you to take.
- "Birth" the placemat by sewing the top and bottom (batting between), leaving a small section for turning it right side out. Finish the opening and stitch around the edge to secure.
- If you prefer doing a binding, consider doing it on the machine to save time.
- Have fun! These become addictive and are a great in-between project to whip up.

Sharing your talent with the community is so appreciated! I wish you all could be with me when I deliver them to Meals on Wheels to see the smiles and excitement!
