And a busy month it is! We are booked solid with Mother's Day events, graduations, school events and more. It's hard to work in enough quilt time!


Please bring your mini quilt items if they are ready! We may start a panic if we wait til August to see what beauties will be available.

Red Dress Project























AQG GENERAL MEETING MINUTES 4/20/17
