Placemat Ideas

Do you have some 5" squares hanging around? A few strips of fabric that aren't for a special project? Consider whipping up a few placemats for our Meals on Wheels Project.

Start with a piece of batting approximately 15"x19" (I like Natural Wonder for stability)

Attach strips of fabric horizontally, vertically or cattywumpass. Utilize the stitch and flip method in which you are sewing through the top fabrics and batting and flipping piece by piece. Doing 2 or more placemats at a time saves time because you can continuous sew. Square up.

Those 5" squares? Layout 3 x3 (9 squares). Sew rows of 3 squares together without going through the batting. Then sew the three strips of (3) 5" squares each down through the batting, centering the first strip. Add $2\frac{1}{2}$ to 3" strips to each side sewing through batting. Square up.

If you have a motif you want to fussy cut and use, place it where you want it and add strips as needed to complete the placemat utilizing the flip and sew technique.

In all cases, sew the top right side down to the backing, leaving a small area to turn the package. Turn to right sides. Stitch the opening closed. Top stitch to secure.
