Fabric Fanatic Community Sew-In Thursday, November 19 3:00-8:00pm



GLAZED PUMPKIN COOKIE RECIPE

2 ½ cups all-purpose flour

1 tsp baking powder AND 1 tsp baking soda

2 tsp ground cinnamon

½ tsp ground nutmeg, ½ tsp ground cloves, and ½ tsp salt

½ cup butter, softened

1 ½ cups white sugar

1 cup canned pumpkin puree

1 egg

1 tsp vanilla extract

GLAZE:

1 tsp vanilla extract

2 cups confectioners' sugar

3 TBS milk

1 TBS melted butter

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Combine flour, baking powder, baking soda, cinnamon, nutmeg, cloves, and salt; set aside.

In a medium bowl, cream together the ½ cup of butter & white sugar. Add pumpkin, egg and 1 tsp vanilla to butter mixture, and beat until creamy.

Mix in dry ingredients. Drop on cookie sheet by tablespoonful's.

Bake for 15 to 20 minutes (ovens vary) in the preheated oven. Cool cookies, then drizzle glaze with fork.

To make the glaze:

Combine confectioners' sugar, milk and 1 TBS melted butter, and 1 tsp vanilla. Add milk as needed, to achieve drizzling consistency.

Store them in an air-tight container to prevent them from drying out. They will be GONE, GONE, GONE.
