It's August - the time for Back to School and summer heat.






# 2021 Raffle Quilt "Kaleidoscope"

### Ready to Make Some Placemats?

I was so excited to deliver 104 placemats to Meals on Wheels last year! The recipients love them! Can we do it again?

- Try a new block design.
- > Use fabric you have! Dot and I have kits available if you prefer.
- Larger batting scraps can be seamed to create the size you need.
- Contact me if you need pattern ideas.
- A finished edge is important, but it doesn't have to be a hand-sewn binding. Look for other techniques including sewing right sides together, flip and secure.
- Placemats should be about 14"x18". A plate and glass etc. need to fit.
- ➢ A quick, fun project.
