

See Paula Z and Alice G. at the membership table.



There will be 2 readings of the bylaws.... January & February. Then after all revisions are made, we will vote on accepting them in April. HAPPY READING!!!!

Block of the Month

MADNESS by Roxy...

The Block of the Month for 2024 will be a **Mystery Quilt**. It is designed to be a patriotic quilt using red, white, and blue but feel free to choose your own color palette. The fabric needed specifications are if you follow the instructions given each month. You can alter the fabric colors, make it scrappy or change any of the designs to ones you prefer. This will, of course, affect the fabric needed.

I happen to have a Wilmington patriotic layer cake and used about half of it, along with some fabric in my stash, to complete the quilt. One caution, you will need a $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF in both red and white. The finished quilt will measure 46.5" x 48". You can alter the last row to larger blocks if you wish to make a bigger quilt. Just remember to include those blocks in the fabric requirements. QOV is minimum 60" x 80".

You will be making the blocks and then putting them together to make the quilt top. We will have a Mystery Quilt "Show & Tell" in September!

Fabrics Needed:

Background (light) 1-2/3 yd

Red 3/4 yd

Blue 1/2-yard

Dark Blue FQ

White 1/4 yard

Green FQ

Yellow FQ

Brown FQ

Scraps will work for these colors.

ALERT! The fabric needed shown is WITHOUT borders or if you add another row to make the quilt large enough for QOV standard size of 60" x 80". You will need to calculate extra fabric.

Block of the Month February: Hearts

February is the month of hearts, valentines, and friendship. It only makes sense for the Block of the Month in February to be hearts. You will need one heart block for each quilt top you are making. Remember, the color palette is your choice, but it looks great in red, white & blue for our Veterans.

Fabric Needed:

Red: cut four 3 ½" x 6 ½" red rectangles. Blue: cut four 3 ½" x 6 ½" blue rectangles.

Background: cut sixteen 2" x 2" rectangles, eight 3 ½" x 3 ½" squares. One 2 ½" x 12 ½"

rectangle

Draw a diagonal line on the back of each background square.

You will be making 4 hearts: two red and 2 blue (or you can make them all one color or scrappy.)

Left side of the heart:

Align a 2" x 2" background square right-side-down on the upper left corner of a colored rectangle with the marked line oriented as shown. Sew on the marked line, trim excess fabric, and press.

Sew a 3 ½" background square to the bottom of the left-side rectangle, position its marked line as shown. Sew on diagonal line, trim the excess fabric and press.

Right side of the heart:

Align a 2" x 2" background square right-side-down on upper right corner of the rectangle and sew on the diagonal line. Trim excess fabric and press.

Sew a 3 ½" background square on the bottom right side, trim, press the seam allowance in the opposite direction you pressed in the left block half for less bulk.

Sew the two heart block halves together vertically to complete the block.

Press. The heart quilt block should measure 6 1/2" x 6 1/2."









Repeat to make four heart blocks.

Sew together as shown (or all four up) to form a 12 $\frac{12}{2}$ " keart block. Sew a background strip (2 $\frac{12}{2}$ " x 12 $\frac{12}{2}$ ") to the top of the heart block.
