

Barn Raising Traditional with a twist

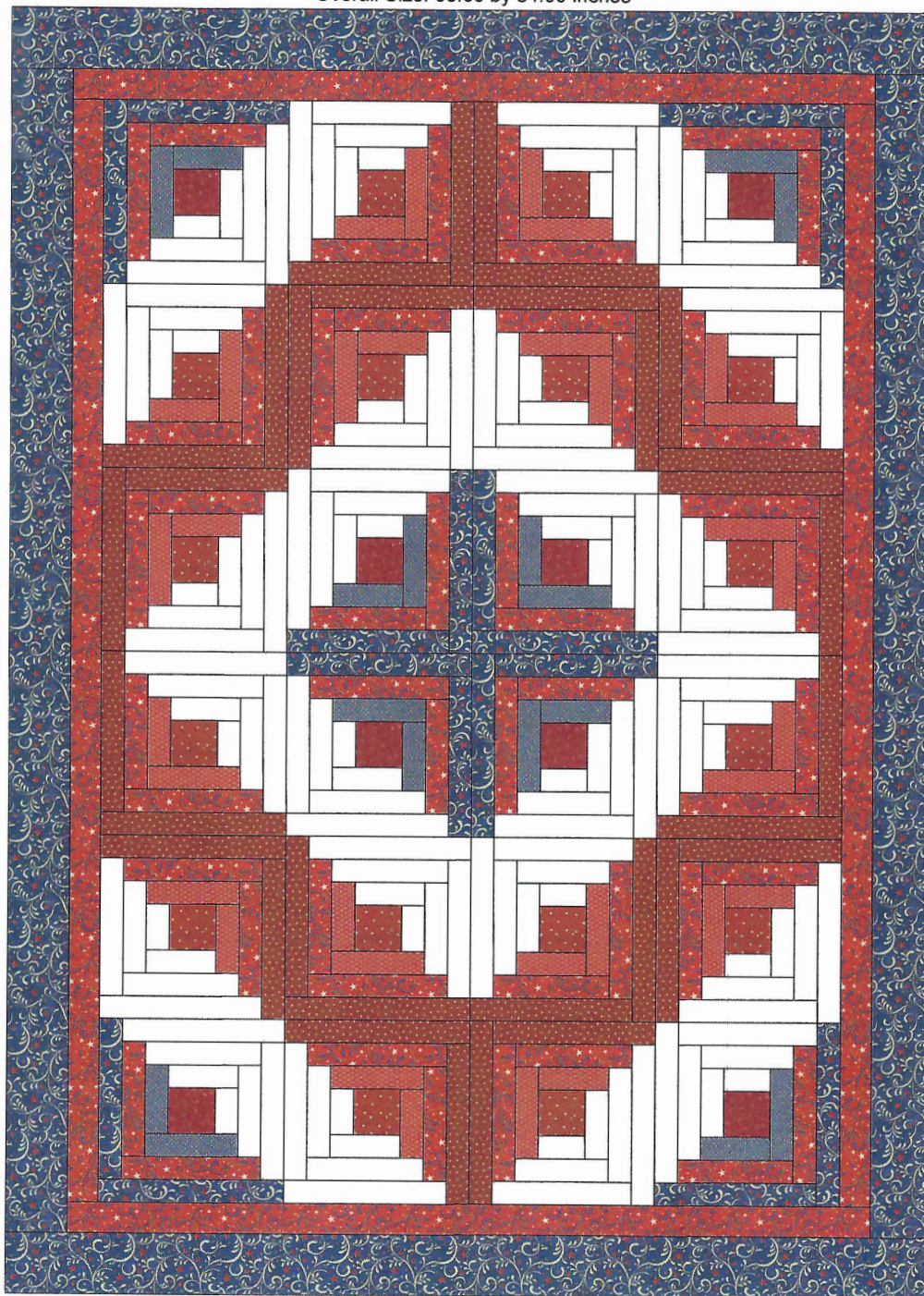
Overall Size: 60.00 by 84.00 inches

General strip cutting:

- 1) 3 1/2" X 3 1/2" **Red**
- 2) 2" X 3 1/2" white/ cream
- 3) 2" X 5" white/ cream
- 4) 2" X 5" **Lt red**
- 5) 2" X 6 1/2" **Lt. red**
- 6) 2" X 6 1/2" white/ cream
- 7) 2" X 8" white/ cream
- 8) 2" X 8" md blue/ md red
- 9) 2" X 9 1/2" md blue/ md red
- 10) 2" X 9 1/2" white/ cream
- 11) 2" X 11" white/ cream
- 12) 2" X 11" dk blue/ dk red
- 13) 2" X 12 1/2" dk blue/ dk red

Cut this number of strips for each color per cutting size chart above.

Cut 24 red center block
Cut 20 white/cream(6 sizes)
Cut 18 lt. red
Cut 26 med. red
Cut 14 dark red
Cut 8 med blue
Cut 8 dark blue



Barn Raising:

All strips 2" X wof

Red #1 5
Red #2 12
Red #3 12

Cut this many 2 inch strips per each color. Then subcut per "General Strip Cutting" on the left.

Blue #1 3
Blue #2 6

White = white or cream

White #1 5
White #2 9
White #3 14

Red center block
3 1/2" X 3 1/2" cut 24

Barn Raising

Make 8 blue/ red/ blue blocks

Make 16 red/ red/ red blocks

Inner border:
Cut 8 strips 2 1/2" X wof

Outer border:
Cut 8 strips 4 1/2" X wof

Use diagonal piecing technique for piecing border strips and binding strips.

Binding: Cut 7 strips 2 1/2" X wof
