All strips 2" X wof

Red #1 9

Blue #1 6

Blue #2 12

White = white or cream

White #1 5

White #2 8

White #3 11

Red center block 3 1/2" X 3 1/2" cut 20

Star in the Middle

Make 20 blue/ red/ blue blocks

Inner border: Cut 8 strips 2 ½" X wof

Outer border: Cut 8 strips 4 ½" X wof

Use diagonal piecing technique for piecing border strips and binding strips.

Binding: Cut 7 strips 2 1/2" X wof

Use your favorite method for creating quarter square triangles (qst) or use your die cut machine.

You will need four 6 1/2" unfinished, blue/ white qst, 1 blue 6 1/2" square, 4 white 6 1/2" squares
