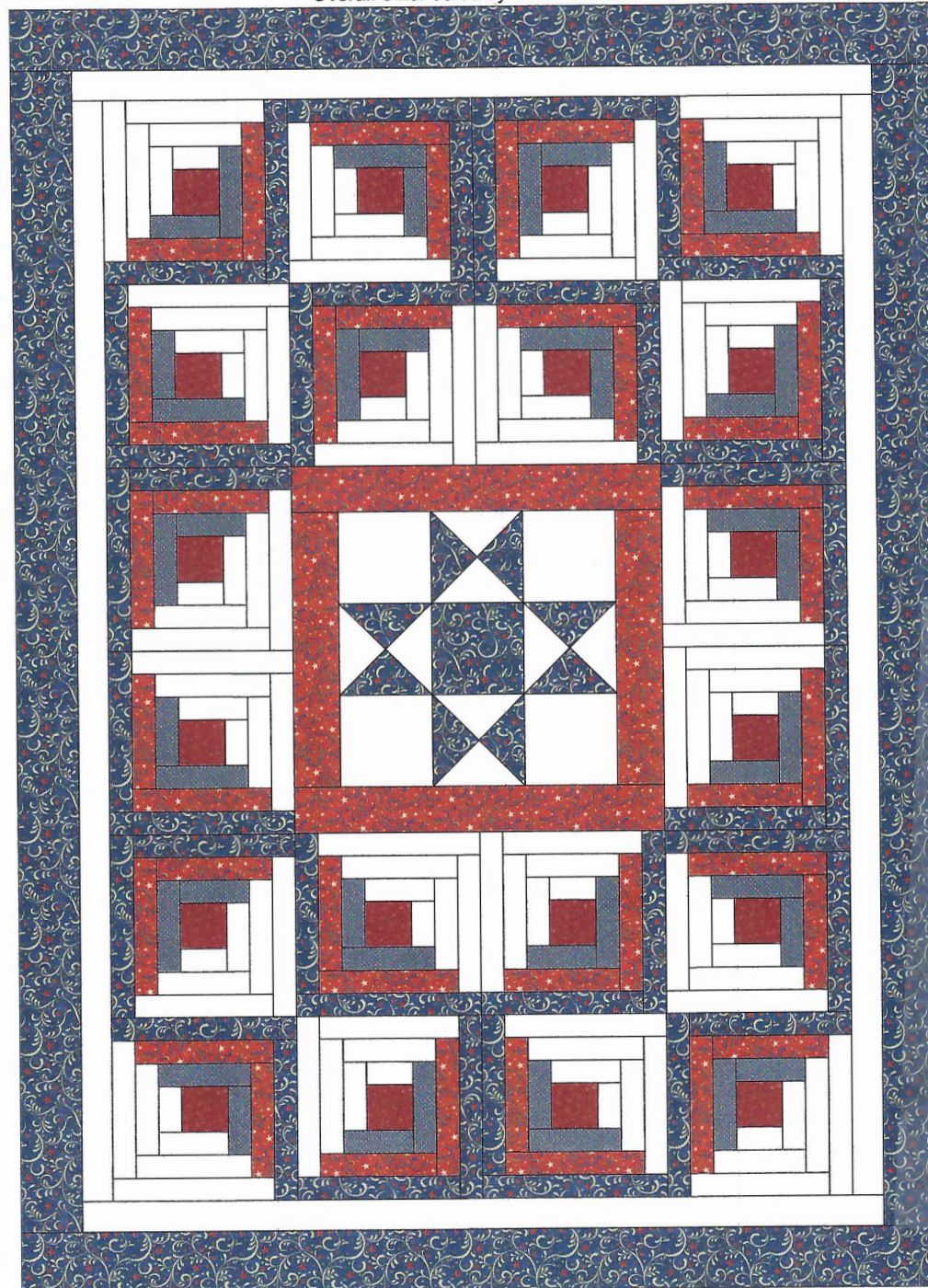


Star in the Middle By Nancy Cann

Overall Size: 60.00 by 84.00 inches

General strip cutting:

- 1) $3\frac{1}{2}" \times 3\frac{1}{2}"$
- 2) $2" \times 3\frac{1}{2}"$ white/ cream
- 3) $2" \times 5"$ white/ cream
- 4) $2" \times 5"$ lt. blue/ lt. red
- 5) $2" \times 6\frac{1}{2}"$ lt. blue/ lt. red
- 6) $2" \times 6\frac{1}{2}"$ white/ cream
- 7) $2" \times 8"$ white/ cream
- 8) $2" \times 8"$ md blue/ md red
- 9) $2" \times 9\frac{1}{2}"$ md blue/ md red
- 10) $2" \times 9\frac{1}{2}"$ white/ cream
- 11) $2" \times 11"$ white/ cream
- 12) $2" \times 11"$ dk blue/ dk red
- 13) $2" \times 12\frac{1}{2}"$ dk blue/ dk red



Star in the Middle

All strips $2" \times \text{wof}$

Red #1 9

Blue #1 6
Blue #2 12

White = white or cream
White #1 5
White #2 8
White #3 11

Red center block
 $3\frac{1}{2}" \times 3\frac{1}{2}"$ cut 20

Star in the Middle

Make 20 blue/ red/ blue blocks

Inner border:
Cut 8 strips $2\frac{1}{2}" \times \text{wof}$

Outer border:
Cut 8 strips $4\frac{1}{2}" \times \text{wof}$

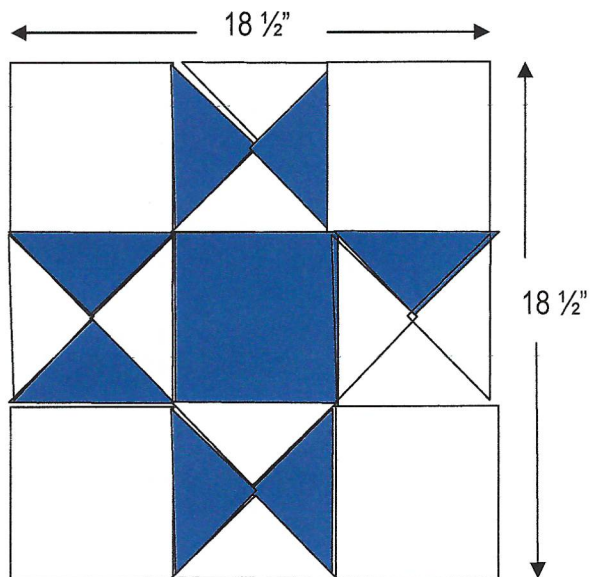
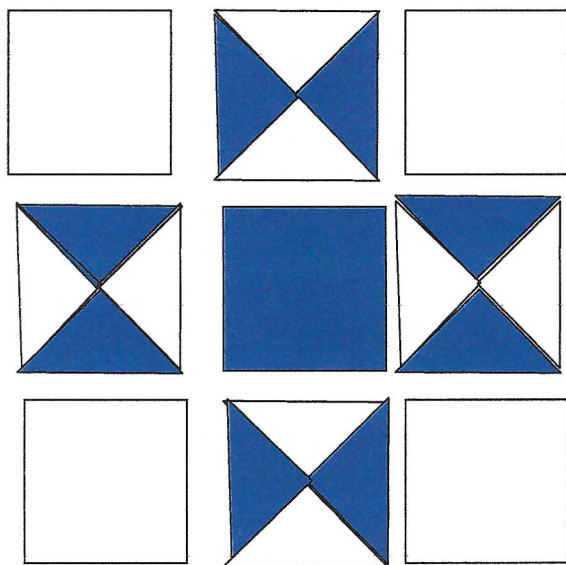
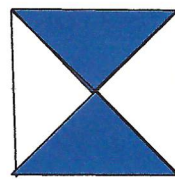
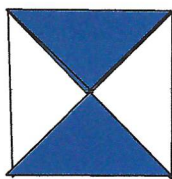
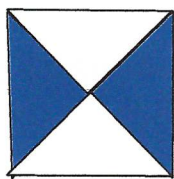
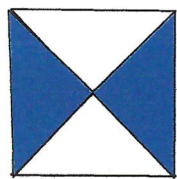
Use diagonal piecing technique for piecing border strips and binding strips.

Binding: Cut 7 strips $2\frac{1}{2}" \times \text{wof}$

Star in the Middle

Use your favorite method for creating quarter square triangles (qst) or use your die cut machine.

You will need four $6\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished, blue/ white qst, 1 blue $6\frac{1}{2}$ " square, 4 white $6\frac{1}{2}$ " squares



Cut 2 side borders $3\frac{1}{2}$ " X $18\frac{1}{2}$ "

Cut top and bottom borders $3\frac{1}{2}$ " X $24\frac{1}{2}$ " each

Sew to Ohio star block.
