### Cheryl's Snickerdoodle Cookie Recipe (from November's meeting) YUM!

*Snickerdoodle Cookies350\* 8-10 min* 

1 cup unsalted butter1-1/2 cups sugar2 eggs2-3/4 cups flour2 tsp. cream of tartar1/2 tsp baking soda

1/2 tsp. salt

Sugar/Cinnamon coating

Cream butter, sugar, and eggs. Sift and stir in the other dry ingredients. Chill dough. Roll into small balls into sugar/cinnamon mixture. Place about 2 inches apart on an ungreased cookie sheet. Bake about 8-10 minutes.

#### Welcome

Quilting-related items that have been donated to the guild are available tonight from which members may select and will be available at the mid-meeting break and for a few minutes after the close of the meeting. Remaining items will be donated to the All Community Outreach (ACO) and the Allen Public Library.

We have two members who will be speaking to us tonight. Elaine to give us information on QOV and Deb to help us learn what is needed to be a show winning quilter and how to prep your quilt for a long armer. We are going to break up the meeting and hear from Elaine before the business meeting.

Dues Reminder: It is the annual membership renewal time. Dues are \$35.

<u>Survey:</u> The board has prepared a survey for members to complete, and it was attached to the email sent with the November newsletter. Thanks to all who completed and returned the survey. This information will help the board to meet the needs of all our members. The results will be shared at a future guild meeting.

<u>Allen Arts Alliance:</u> As a member of the Allen Arts Alliance, the guild is not charged a fee for the use of the Blue House Too Gallery for our monthly membership meetings. Guild members have 2 significant opportunities to provide assistance at AAA events in the spring and fall which typically involves volunteers to sit at the information-volunteer sign-in table (located inside the Blue House Too Gallery), deliver water bottles to vendors and provide vendor relief.
