## Celebration Time

To make this quilt you will need **Quilt in A Day Triangle in a Square** (3"/ 4") specialty ruler set.

### Fabric requirements:

1776-2026: 2  $\frac{1}{4}$  yards

Cut 6 - 12  $\frac{1}{2}$ " X wof strips. Sub cut to 17 - 12  $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares. (snowballs)

Red w/stars: 1  $\frac{1}{2}$  yards

Cut 7 - 3  $\frac{1}{2}$ " X wof strips. Sub cut to 68 - 3  $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares. (snowball corners)

Cut 5 - 5" X wof strips. Sub cut to 36 - 5" squares. (four patches)

### Following cutting instructions for 4" Triangle in Square patches:

Sand color: 1  $\frac{3}{4}$  yard

Cut 6 - 5" X wof strips. Sub cut to 72 triangles using specialty ruler. (stars)

Cut 5 - 5" X wof strips. Sub cut to 36 - 5" squares. (four patches)

Blue w/stars: 2  $\frac{1}{2}$  yards

Cut 6 - 6" X wof strips. **Fold right sides together**. Cut 72 - 3" X 6" rectangles.

Cut 3 - 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " X wof strips. Sub cut to 18 - 4  $\frac{1}{4}$ " squares. (star center square)


Binding: 5/8 yard

Cut 8 - 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " X wof strips

### Making the Snowball Block:

Materials: 1 - 12  $\frac{1}{2}$ " square, 4 - 3  $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

1. Draw diagonal line across each of the 4 - 3  $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.
2. Sew one 3  $\frac{1}{2}$ " square to each corner of the 12  $\frac{1}{2}$ " block sewing on the diagonal line drawn.
3. Trim each seam to  $\frac{1}{4}$ " and Press seams open.
4. Make 17 Snowball Blocks.





### Making the Star Parts


Please use the Quilt in a Day Triangle in Square 3"/4" specialty ruler set and instructions for constructing the star points for the star block. The cutting instructions were taken from that instruction sheet. **Hint:** Always store the instruction sheet with the rulers.

### Making the Four Patches

1. With right sides together place a 5" square of background fabric on a 5" square of main fabric. Stitch  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam on opposite sides of the unit. Cut the unit in half so that each piece measures  $2\frac{1}{2}$ ".
2. Set seam then press to dark fabric.



3. With the two patch units right sides together, seams aligned, and the dark and light fabrics opposite each other, stitch  $\frac{1}{4}$ " from opposite sides.



4. Press to set seams then press seam to one side. You have 2 -  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " four patches.
5. Make 72 -  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " four patches.

### Finishing:

All of your blocks should square to  $12\frac{1}{2}$ "

Using the quilt diagram, complete the quilt top by sewing blocks into rows and rows into the quilt top. Quilt as desired.
