


# Echoes and Floating Pinwheel

## Echoes and Floating Pinwheel **(Estimated)** Yardage and cutting requirements

### **White: 3 yards**

Cut 13 - 5 ½" x wof strips. Sub cut to 136 - 3" X 5 ½" rectangles for Pinwheels and 36 for Echoes block.

Cut 3 - 3" X wof strips. Sub cut to 36 - 3" X 3" squares for Echoes block.

Cut 7 - 2 ½" X wof strips for inner border.

### **Blue: 1 yards:**

Cut 2 - 5 ½" x wof strips. Sub cut to 18 - 3" X 5 ½" rectangles for Echoes block.

Cut 7 - 3" X wof sub cut to 18 - 3" X 3" squares for Echo block and 68 - 3" X 3" squares for Pinwheel..

### **Red: 1 ¼ yards**

Cut 2 - 5 ½" X wof strips. Sub cut to 18 - 3" X 5 ½" rectangles for echoes blocks.

Cut 2 - 3" X wof strips. Sub cut to 18 - 3" X 3" squares for Echoes blocks.

### **Flags: 2 yards**

Echoes center blocks: cut 18 - 5 ½" squares all the same or many different fabrics.

Cut 8 - 4 ½" X wof strips for outer border.



**Echoes Block** 10" finished block (10 1/2" unfinished)

Block One

Center: 1-5 1/2" focus square (A)  
 Blue: 2-3" X 5 1/2" rectangles (B), 2-3" squares (C)  
 White: 2-3" squares (D), 2-3" X 5 1/2" rectangles (E)


Block Two

Center: 1-5 1/2" square (A)  
 Red: 2-3" X 5 1/2" rectangles (B), 2-3" squares (C)  
 White: 2-3" squares (D), 2-3" X 5 1/2" rectangles (E)




Sewing instructions are the same for Blocks 1, 2, and 3.



1. Sew one C to one D. Repeat for the other C and D.




2. Sew one B to one E. Repeat for the other B and E.






3. Sew units together as shown. Follow arrows for pressing.



Block Three (option)






## Complimentary block for use with 10 1/2" Echoes Block.

### Floating Pinwheel block:

Pieces needed for one pinwheel block: eight 3" x 5 1/2" white rectangles, four 3" x 3" main color squares.




Draw one diagonal line on wrong side of each MC fabric square as shown.





Place the MC square on a white rectangle as shown. Line direction is important.

Sew ON the drawn line. Cut 1/4" from the sewn line. Press seam open.




Sew a white 3" x 5 1/2" rectangle to the left side of the pieced triangle/rectangle unit. Make 4 units. These units will measure 5 1/2" square. Arrange 4 units as shown below.



## Adding multiple borders to your quilt.

1. Side borders: measure the length of your quilt through the center length, the length of quilt along the left side about 3" in from the edge, and the length of the quilt along the right side about 3" in, as designated by red arrows in left diagram below. Add these three measurements together, divide by 3 and this will be the length to cut your side borders.
2. Mark side center of quilt and center of side borders. Pin left border to quilt at center, top, and bottom. Sew in place. Repeat to add the right border.
3. Top and Bottom borders: measure the width of your quilt across the center, across the top about 3" down from the top, and across the bottom about 3" up from the bottom designated by blue arrows in diagram below left. Add these three measurements together, divide by 3 and this will be the width to cut your top and bottom borders. Mark border strip centers and quilt centers, pin and sew borders into place.



Repeat steps 1 - 3 for each additional border; this will insure a more square quilt top and less ripple in the borders.
